

Materials Needed at Every Rehearsal:

- Pencils
- Three-ring binder and sheet music
- Three-ring pencil pouch

Grading System:

50% - Singing tests, quizzes, and concerts

- Students perform singing tests in class or record themselves in another room/at home.
- Most quizzes are written tests that cover music theory and vocabulary.
- Students are expected to attend all *required* concerts (**listed in bold on the calendar**)
- Students who miss a required event need to submit a make-up assignment within ten days of the event (instructions for the assignment can be found on our website).
- *Optional* events are not part of a student's grade.
- Most optional events require auditions, paperwork, or student fees; make sure you plan ahead and communicate with Mr. Zieske if you are interested in these extra activities.

30% - Daily grade (participation, preparedness, etc.)

- Students are expected to come to every class prepared (see materials above).
- Students are expected to be engaged and participate in every rehearsal.

20% - Class assignments

• Assignments cover technique, vocabulary, music theory, history, composition, and more.
